

CURICULLUM VITAE

Professor Kostas Chryssogonos was born in 1961. He graduated with honors (9.90/10) in 1983 from the Department of Law of the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki. He earned his PhD in 1987 at the University of Hannover with the grade magna cum laude. Lecturer at the Department of Law from 1990, assistant Professor from 1993, associate Professor from 1999. In 2003 he was unanimously elected as full Professor of Constitutional Law of the University of Thessaloniki. He taught the same discipline in the Greek National School for Judges, the Hellenic Open University and, as visiting Professor, at the Universities of Regensburg, Bayreuth and Hannover. He has served as a Counselor of the National Center for Public Administration and as a member of the Central Legislative Committee, the National Council for Radio and Television, and as member of the Board of Directors of the Union of Greek Constitutionalists and the European Centre of Constitutional Law. He has participated as a rapporteur in a great number of scientific conferences in Greece and abroad. He has published approximately 20 books, between which the handbooks “Constitutional Law” and “Civil and Social Rights” and more than 100 studies in law reviews and edited volumes in Greek, English and German. He speaks English, German and French. He often writes articles in the daily press and pursues an active legal practice. On May 2014 he was elected member of the European Parliament and has developed intense parliamentary activity centered on the violation of fundamental rights, taking place through austerity programs enforced in Greece and other European countries.
