As a Greek Scholarships Institution scholar she continued her studies at a postgraduate level on European Communities Law at the Freie Universität in (West) Berlin. She obtained her doctorate degree from the School of Law and Economics, Aristotle University Thessaloniki in 1985. She teaches European Communities and European Union Law in Thessaloniki since 1986. She has also taught European Law at the postgraduate lessons of the Law School in Athens, at the Erlangen - Nürnberg University in Germany and at the Greek National School of Judges. Her primary interests are in the areas of Institutional European Union Law, Economic Law of the Internal European Market and Judicial Cooperation in Civil and Commercial Matters. She has published several books and articles in scientific journals, among them, books on the Non Contractual Liability of the European Communities, on the Freedom to provide Television Services in the European Community, on the European Court of Justice and its Contribution to the European Integration and on Jurisdiction Agreements according to the Brussels I Regulation as well as articles on the Protection of the Fundamental Rights in the European Communities, on the Implementation of Community Law in Greece, on Judicial Review and the Role of the European Court of Justice in the EC Treaty and on the Principle of Subsidiarity according to the European Union Treaty. She is member of several scientific organizations, vice president of the Governing Board of the Kalliopi Koufa Foundation for the Promotion of International and Human Rights Law and she has participated in several national and international conferences.
