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He teaches, "Public International Law", "International Protection of Human Rights", Law of Armed Conflict, Law of International Organizations, Law of the Use of Force and Collective Security, International Relations, and International Law of the Sea at the undergraduate and graduate Programme of Studies as well as the Erasmus Programme. He supervises doctoral dissertations and master thesis and coaches students who participate to Model United Nations simulations (MUNs) and International Moot Court Competitions.

He also lectures/ed in many academic and professional institutions around Greece. These include the Department of Political Science of the Democritus University of Thrace, the Department of Language, Literature and Culture of the Black Sea Countries of the Democritus University of Thrace, the School of Economics, Business Administration & Legal Studies of the International Hellenic University, the Hellenic Open University, the Department of Logistics of the Technological Education Institution of Central Macedonia, and the Department of Public Relations and Communication of the Technological Education Institution of Western Macedonia. Moreover, he is a lecturer at the Police Academy/School of Lifelong Education and Training of Northern Greece, the Supreme Joint Command School of War of the Ministry of Defence, and the Multinational Peace Support Operations Training Center of the Ministry of Defence. He is an acting member of the governing boards of the Aegean Institute on the Law of the Sea and Maritime Law, of the Hellenic Society of International Law and International Relations and of the Centre for Pontic Studies. He is also an expert (CIMIC) in humanitarian law for NATO Rapid Deployable Corps (NRDC-GR).

His main research interests focus on the UN legal order, international organization, collective security, the use of force and pacific dispute settlement, humanitarian law, the international protection of human rights, and foreign policy. He has written monographs, textbooks and publishes in Greek and foreign journals and collective works.
